Student Dress - Our Standard

- Students who are inappropriately dressed or groomed will be referred to the Dean of Programme or Head of School, who makes the final decisions on dress code matters.

Adherence to the Uniform Standard

If there are any questions related to a student's clothing, the decision of the school is final. CVWS follows a three-step process for adherence to the dress code standard:

- Students not in their proper, full uniform will receive a verbal warning.
- If a second instance occurs, you will receive a written warning, and a conference will be scheduled to review the uniform requirements and your student's adherence to the standard.
- Should a third instance occur, the school will provide your student with a uniform, and your TADS account will be charged for the cost.
