Inclusion at Creation Village World School

Creation Village World School agrees with IB's premise that "Inclusion is an ongoing process that aims to increase access and engagement in learning for all students by identifying and removing barriers." (Learning Diversity in the International Baccalaureate Programmes). All administrators, teachers, faculty members, and students are vital members of our community and necessary to create an inclusive environment. All students are included in the MYP. Creation Village World School attempts to address all barriers that create inequities in a student's learning and social progression. The following are potential barriers to student learning:

- Race
- Gender
- Culture
- Ethnicity
- Socioeconomics
- Learning and physical disabilities
- Emotional and behavioral disorders
- Religious or spiritual beliefs

To remove barriers for our students, we have enacted the following interventions:

- Inclusive admission policy for incoming students
- Scholarship opportunities for lower-income families (Step Up, MacKay)
- Access to a mental health professional as needed
- Access to pastoral care and counseling services (Behavorial) on campus: Pastor Brad Cassell
- Designated student emotional specialists consulted when needed for interventions
- Educational modifications and accommodations from data points including:
 - Formative and summative assessments
 - MAP testing.
 - Faculty observations

Inclusion and the Learner Profile

To further promote inclusion, we provide focused instruction on the Learner Profile attributes in each grade level. In line with IB's philosophy, we believe that students who develop the ten Learner Profile attributes will show more empathy and compassion for themselves and those in need and have a healthy perspective to help them progress academically and socially. The Learner Profile is a critical part of the student portfolios and their monitoring through progress reports.

Support for students and their teachers

Creation Village World School works with the families directly for student evaluation and provides access to private services as needed. A designated faculty member coordinates this process in middle school.

Teacher Collaboration

Where students have support in class, teachers will collaborate with the student support assistant, who in turn, reports to the Head of School.

The special education Service Provider, Case Manager or Inclusion Manager and the general education teacher will participate in problem solving to assure proper inclusion of students with disabilities.
